September 2018 – Present

- Lead the design and implementation of a feature written in Java (Android) and Objective-C (iOS) for Lutron's mobile apps that warns the user when their home lighting control system nears maximum device capacity, aiming to significantly reduce related tech support calls
- Conduct user research by polling alpha/beta testers and studying app-collected analytics to create a software design that closely aligns with user requirements
- Fill in as UX designer by creating wireframes and mockups to assist the UX team when their workload is heavy
